



OPIRG Peterborough is Hiring – Contract, must be TWSP Eligible

Position: Volunteer and Outreach Coordinator

Reports to: OPIRG Peterborough Coordinator

Compensation: 160 hours at \$19.05 per hour.

Anticipated start date: October 16, 2023

OPIRG Peterborough works to create and sustain student and community-based engagement through research, education and action on social justice and environmental issues; challenging oppression in all its forms; and using consensus-based decision-making in a non-hierarchical and accessible setting.

The Volunteer and Outreach Coordinator will work with the OPIRG Peterborough staff and Board of Directors to:

- Recruit, orient (safety and training), support, and maintain committed volunteers. Acts as main contact for volunteers.
- Develops volunteer schedules and signs off on volunteer hours (ex. Highschool students who volunteer and need proof of hours completed)
- Organize and update volunteer files/resources and help working groups to access the resources available at OPIRG.
- Works alongside the Outreach and Programming Liaison (Board member) to connect with a variety of partners and community organizations.
- Liaise with OPIRG's working groups by attending working group meetings and by offering organizational support to the working groups.
- Liaise with Special Events Coordinator on events to support and engage students in developing working groups.
- Publicize our working groups, volunteer opportunities/appreciation, and events through our website, Twitter, Instagram, Facebook, posters, and newsletter.
- Take on additional tasks as required.
- This position may require evenings and/or weekends work.

Qualifications:

- Must be TWSP eligible
- Strong written and verbal communication and interpersonal skills.
- Commitment to anti-oppression and consensus-based decision making.
- Demonstrated ability to work well as part of a team and ability to work well with diverse groups of people, treating everyone in a fair, supportive and cooperative



manner.

- Good organizational and time management skills, ability to stay focused and meet deadlines with frequent interruptions.
- Ability to work independently, take initiative, make good judgments, and show discretion when working with minimal supervision.
- Ability to develop and give oral presentations to both large and small groups.
- Good leadership, planning, and problem-solving skills.
- Familiarity with how to promote events using social media sites.
- Strong computer skills.

Term and Compensation:

About 8 hours a week for 20 weeks (160 hours total, TWSP guidelines) at \$19.05 per hour.
